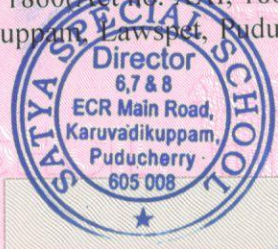
For Collaboration on a Telemedicine Project

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Sri Venkateshwaraa Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Ariyur, Puducherry-605102, a healthcare institution registered under the section 10(A) of IMC Act 1956, having its principal place at Ariyur, Puducherry – 605102 (hereinafter referred to as the “Second Party”)

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a collaborative framework between the NGO and the Hospital for the implementation and operation of a **Telemedicine Project** aimed at improving access to quality healthcare services for underserved and remote populations.

The Telemedicine Project Functional at Satya Special School, Plot 61-64, Yogalakshmi Nagar, Muttrampattu Village, Vikravandi (TK), Villupuram (DT) Manjanayakan Palayam, Tamilnadu -605501, shall include, but not be limited to:

- Online medical consultations via telemedicine platforms (med.bot)
- Non-emergency consultations and follow-ups
- Health awareness and preventive care services
- Capacity building and training of staff working in telemedicine centre
- Referral of patients for to higher centre when required

The First Party (Satya Special School) agrees to:

1. Coordinate and manage community outreach and patient enrollment
2. Provide or facilitate telemedicine infrastructure, where applicable
3. Ensure patient awareness, consent, and basic support during consultations
4. Assist in project monitoring, reporting, and documentation
5. Comply with all applicable laws, ethical standards, and data protection requirements

The Second Party (Sri Venkateshwaraa Medical College Hospital and Research Centre, Ariyur):

1. Provide qualified medical professionals for telemedicine consultations
2. Ensure medical services are delivered in accordance with professional and ethical standards
3. Maintain accurate medical records related to telemedicine consultations
4. Provide referrals for in-person treatment when medically necessary
5. Comply with applicable healthcare regulations and patient confidentiality requirements

Both Parties agree to:

- Maintain strict confidentiality of patient data and medical records
- Use patient information solely for the purposes of the Telemedicine Project
- Comply with applicable data protection and privacy laws
- Obtain informed consent from patients prior to consultations

Financial Arrangements

This MoU does not create any financial obligation between the Parties unless otherwise agreed in writing. Any costs, funding arrangements, or reimbursements shall be governed by a separate written agreement, if applicable.

Monitoring and Evaluation

The Parties shall jointly:

- Review the progress of the Telemedicine Project periodically
- Share non-confidential reports and impact assessments
- Make improvements to enhance service quality and reach

Term and Termination

1. This MoU shall be valid for a period of 2 years from the date of signing.
2. Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing 30 days' written notice to the other Party.
3. Termination shall not affect ongoing patient care already initiated under this MoU.

Non-Legal Binding Nature

This MoU is a statement of mutual understanding and cooperation and does not create any legally binding obligations, except for clauses relating to confidentiality and data protection.

Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising under this MoU shall be resolved amicably through mutual consultation between the Parties.

Amendments

This MoU may be amended only by a written document signed by authorized representatives of both Parties.

Governing Law

This MoU shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of .
