BY AND BETWEEN:

WHEREAS SVGI,

(iv) Siddhanta will help set up "**Siddhanta Learning Center (SLC)**" within the campus, under which several activities and programs will be organized such as Siksha Klub, Hands-on Indic Games, Bhajan Mandali, Self-Health Care and Emotional Wellness Program, Research Lab, Incubation and Internship, Faculty Exchange Portal etc. SLC adopts a participatory model involving students, faculty and institutional leadership enabling sustained engagement. It brings together culture, research, wellness, skill development and community engagement to enable students experience IKS as a living contemporary knowledge tradition rather than a static subject of study.

SVGI will be represented by its Chief Operating Officer, **Smt. Dr. B. Vidhya**, as Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for all operational requirements

AND

Siddhanta Knowledge Foundation (SKF) and its associates, Siddhanta Group, will be represented by its Authorized signatory or any other representative as nominated by Siddhanta, from time to time as Single Point of Contact (SPOC) for all operational requirements

Accordingly, it has been agreed;

- 1) Siddhanta has offered to SVGI, all the courses available on their LMS which are pre-recorded online courses on Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS).
- 2) SVGI has agreed to include Siddhanta IKS courses starting Academic Year 2026-27 onwards, as suitably selected and mapped to their respective curriculums.
- 3) Siddhanta IKS courses shall be offered to students of SVGI to enable them to earn mandated credits from IKS courses as stipulated by UGC guidelines.
- 4) All terms and conditions pertaining to the integration of Siddhanta IKS courses into the curriculum/ syllabus of SVGI shall be stated separately in an Addendum to this MoU, based on mutual discussions and agreement between both parties.
- 5) Siddhanta shall conduct Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) and Faculty Training Workshops (FTWs) for the faculty of SVGI covering various topics on Indian Knowledge Systems.

- 6) SVGI shall conduct Conclaves/Conferences focused on Indian Knowledge Systems with Siddhanta as Knowledge Partner
- 7) Siddhanta shall help set up "**Siddhanta Learning Center (SLC)**" within the campus of SVGI, with Siddhanta as Knowledge Partner, under which several activities and programs will be organized such as Siksha Klub, Hands-on Indic Games, Bhajan Mandali, Self-Health Care and Emotional Wellness Program, Research Lab, Incubation and Internship, Faculty Exchange Portal etc. SLC adopts a participatory model involving students, faculty and institutional leadership enabling sustained engagement. It brings together culture, research, wellness, skill development and community engagement to enable students experience IKS as a living contemporary knowledge tradition rather than a static subject of study.
- 8) SVGI and Siddhanta shall jointly execute projects to develop easy, effective, and logical learning resources including pedagogy creation, dissemination, and training.
- 9) SVGI and Siddhanta shall collaborate in organising various outreach activities pertaining to traditional knowledge systems and literature including seminars and conferences, lectures, and other events.
- 10) SVGI shall provide access to existing research and academic databases and output as well as networking support with regard to scholars and academicians towards achieving aforementioned obligations.
- 11) Siddhanta shall invest in developing IKS courses utilising research output from SVGI. Such courses shall be offered by Siddhanta in both online and offline modes.
- 12) SVGI and Siddhanta agree to declare their collaboration, in any/all individual and jointly conducted events and announcements, in their respective branding and communication.
- 13) Since this MoU is a basic understanding between the parties, the specific terms of collaboration not covered in this MoU, shall be mutually discussed and decided on a case-to-case basis, which includes funding and delivery.
- 14) In the case of all SVGI courses, offered by Siddhanta on "as-is - where-is state" – the IP ownership shall be with SVGI.
- 15) In the case of courses developed by Siddhanta, the IP ownership shall be with Siddhanta.

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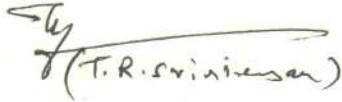
- 16) In case Siddhanta modifies or re-develops SVGI courses – the IP ownership of the modified and/or re-developed course(s) shall be jointly with SVGI and Siddhanta.
- 17) SVGI agrees to share digital links of all its publications like Books, Journals, Videos, Podcasts, Talks, Conferences and Workshops including permission to reuse content from their YouTube channel(s) to enable incorporating select and relevant content suitably in the LMS, Website and/or other portals of Siddhanta group like Siddhanta e-kosha, Siddhanta Gyaan, etc.
- 18) SVGI agrees to provide access to their training halls and video-recording studio facilities to Siddhanta, without any charges.
- 19) Both SVGI and Siddhanta shall enter into commercial agreements in case of any sale or business pertaining to each other's works as part of this assignment, including books, journals and all other things, only with prior written consent of both parties.
- 20) Whereas both parties desire to have a long-term and mutually rewarding relationship, both SVGI and Siddhanta agree to collaborate for a period of 5 (Five) years from the date of signing this MoU. After a period of 5 years, both parties can extend the MoU by mutual consent.
- a. This MoU can be modified at any time by mutual discussion and consent of both parties, in writing.
- b. This MoU can be terminated by either party by issuing a prior notice of 6 months to the other party and subject to completion of on-going projects and their respective obligations.
- c. Upon termination of this MoU, no claims of any nature will be entertained by either party.
- 21) The relationship between the parties created through this MoU, shall be as Principal to Principal and there is no Agency or Partnership created.
- 22) **Arbitration and disputes jurisdiction:** The Proceedings shall be conducted as per Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and its subsequent amendments, if any. The parties hitherto, do hereby agree and record their consent that the jurisdiction of any disputes, arbitration thereof and legal proceedings, if any, shall be limited to the jurisdiction of Chennai and such arbitration proceedings shall only be conducted in the language of English. Initially both parties shall share expenses of Arbitration and shall reimburse as per the final verdict of legal proceedings.


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We, representing the two parties, **SVGI** and **Siddhanta Knowledge Foundation** and its associates, **Siddhanta Group (Siddhanta)**, do hereby sign this MoU on the day and date aforementioned.
