

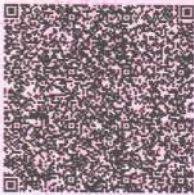

Memorandum of Understanding for Academic, Research & Training Co-operation
between
ICMR-National Institute of Vector Control Research, Puducherry
and
Sri Venkateshwaraa Group of Institution, Ariyur, Puducherry

The ICMR–National Institute of Vector Control Research (NIVCR), Puducherry, and the Sri Venkateshwaraa Group of Institutions (SVGI), Ariyur, under the Ramachandra Educational Trust (RET), recognize their complementary strengths in biomedical research, medical education, public health, disease diagnosis, disease prevention and control, and capacity building. Both institutions share a common commitment to advancing scientific knowledge and promoting excellence through collaborative academic, research, and training activities.

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is to establish a framework for collaboration in areas of mutual interest, including academic programmes, biomedical and public health research, capacity building, scientific exchange, and community health initiatives.

Accordingly, the ICMR–National Institute of Vector Control Research (NIVCR), and the Sri Venkateshwaraa Group of Institutions (SVGI), Ariyur, agree to promote academic, research, and training cooperation in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Memorandum of Understanding.

1.0 OBJECTIVES

The goal is to foster collaboration, to provide opportunities for National experience, and to facilitate the advancement of knowledge on the basis of best effort, mutual benefit, reciprocity, faith, and outcome-oriented interactions between ICMR-NIVCR and SVGIT.

The areas of collaboration are listed hereunder:

- a) Carrying out Human Resource Development activities pertaining to Epidemiology, Entomology, Microbiology, Parasitology, Environmental Sciences, Pharmacology, and Public Health Engineering, with a view to foster One Health.
- b) Brainstorming workshops on research agenda and academic advancements.
- c) Conducting hands-on training on vector-borne diseases for faculties, students, and public health personnel.
- d) Working in areas benefiting felt needs of the Community, National priorities in the field of health research,

The ICMR-NIVCR and SVGIT further agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be separately determined and agreed upon by the two Institutions. These terms shall include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, person(s) responsible for implementation, etc.

2.0 EXCHANGE OF FACULTIES, SCIENTISTS AND STUDENTS

The ICMR-NIVCR and SVGIT agree to encourage collaboration between investigators from the two institutions.

The ICMR-NIVCR and SVGIT agree that students, scientists, and faculty exchange will be guided by principles listed as under:

(a) A home institution refers to the Institution where the student or faculty is a full-time one and from where he/she is expected to graduate. A host institution refers to an institution that receives the student or full-time faculty to undertake a predetermined program of study.

(b) The host institution will evaluate the exchange personnel's performance in the module, award a Certificate of merit/participation, grade or marks and issue a letter to that effect.

(c) The home institution may award to the exchange student credits earned at the host institution.

(d) ICMR-NIVCR and SVGIT agree to provide suitable accommodation (if available), as per their norms for this period of exchange activity.

(e) A program fee stipulated by the host institution as per the current norms will be applicable to the full-time faculty/students on a program to program basis agreed upon mutually, if necessary, only.

3.0 EXCHANGE OF SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL METHODOLOGIES

The ICMR-NIVCR and SVGIT agree to explore ways to share teaching/learning material and other relevant literature while respecting each other's intellectual property and other rights.

4.0 PUBLICATIONS AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Any research findings arising from this collaborative activity may be published/presented at national or international conferences. Acknowledgment of the contribution of the authors towards such publications will be made, as appropriate. However, the terms and conditions for such publications shall be mutually agreed upon.

The ICMR-NIVCR and SVGIT agree to respect each other's rights to Intellectual Property (IP). Further, the IP rights and the proceeds that arise as a result of any collaborative research study or activity, under this MoU will be worked out on a case-to-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down policies of the two institutions.

5.0 COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its full-time teaching/research faculty to coordinate the programme(s) on its behalf. Further a Coordination committee consisting of (a) Director, ICMR-NIVCR or his Nominee (b) Chairman, SVGIT, Ariyur or his Nominee and Program Coordinator from the side of SVGIT, will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two Institutions and to ensure its sustenance.

6.0 TENURE AND TERMINATION

The MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of the two Institutions. It will remain valid for five years and may be continued thereafter after a suitable review and mutual agreement, two months prior to the end of the above period. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution, three months in advance. Once terminated, neither ICMR-NIVCR, Puducherry nor SVGIT, Ariyur will be responsible for any losses financial or otherwise, which the other Institutions may suffer. However, ICMR-NIVCR and SVGIT will guarantee that all activities and progress are allowed to complete successfully.

7.0 ARBITRATION CLAUSE

Should there be any dispute relating to any aspect of academic, research, and training cooperation, Director ICMR-NIVCR, Puducherry, and Chairman SVGIT, Ariyur will jointly resolve the dispute in the spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility. Where it could not be resolved so, then it shall be referred to the arbitration of three arbitrators, one to be appointed by each of the parties. The two arbitrators shall appoint the Third Arbitrator (Umpire) mutually who shall preside over the proceedings. The decision of the said arbitrators shall be final and binding on both all parties. The venue of arbitration shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Courts in Puducherry.

8.0 CONFIDENTIALITY

ICMR-NIVCR and SVGIT, Ariyur agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the parties as being confidential which is obtained/disclosed from either party or created during the performance of this agreement and will not disclose the same to any third party without the written consent of the other party.

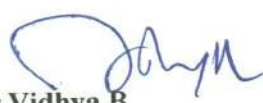
