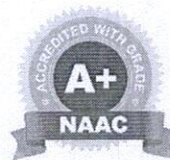

a.	Request for more number of practical / clinical hours than the lecture hours	NMC regulations with CBME suggests for reduction in number of theory hours, which is being followed by the Institute in all the phases of MBBS	The teaching schedule made for all the phases of MBBS includes the specific teaching hours as suggested by NMC, where the practical / clinical hours allotted for each department is appropriate. All the components of the annual schedule are being followed up as per NMC regulations.
b.	ENT & Ophthalmology subjects to be take during Final MBBS part I	NMC suggested ENT & Ophthalmology to be included for summative assessment during Final MBBS part II for MBBS admission during (2021, 2022 & 2023 batch). However NMC revised later with 2024 admission, where ENT & Ophthalmology will be added with Final MBBS part I University examination.	Teaching schedule for Final MBBS part I & II are being taken as per NMC guidelines.
c.	Extension of University examination for Phase I MBBS	Our Institute is affiliated under the Pondicherry University, where the examination schedules are decided by the University. The declaration of results are also getting delayed because of double valuation system being followed up by the University.	Official representation to COE, Pondicherry University can be submitted to align with NMC annual calendar, so the students can complete the course in stipulated time frame.

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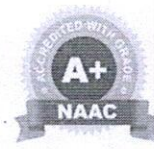


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Student feedback – Hostel, Overall Positive feedback percentage from 45.9% to 91%

S. No	Points discussed	Action proposed	Action Taken
a.	Corridor lights on the 1st floor are not working properly.	The issue was inspected by the maintenance team and discussed with the electrician. Faulty lights were identified.	Defective lights and electrical fittings were replaced, and regular maintenance checks will be carried out.
b.	Clothes given to the laundry are taking excessive time to be returned, and occasionally some items are reported missing.	The matter was discussed with the laundry service provider. Existing procedures for collection and distribution of clothes were reviewed, and staff were instructed to improve monitoring and record-keeping.	A systematic tracking mechanism will be implemented through proper issue and receipt registers/tagging of garments. The laundry service provider will be directed to adhere to the prescribed turnaround time and ensure accountability for missing items.

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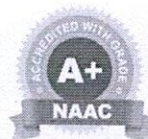
